

PVCA MEETING MINUTES, September 9, 2019

1. Treasurer's Report, Mike Campbell

2. Special Presentation, Brooke Ellis, FDEP Northeast Regional Clean Boating Coordinator

3. Citizens Traffic Task Force (CTTF), Greg Leonard

- Recap of the history, goals, and progress of CTTF, including significant growth in development and traffic in PVB from 2014 onward, 8-10 trips per residential unit, SJC is 13th fastest-growing county in FL, road development takes 15-20 years from idea to implementation and starts with a traffic study, CTTF comprised of major PVB HOA's and represented by 85% of PVB and Palm Valley residents
- Phase 1 identified five critical intersections on A1A; these are Dolphin Blvd., Solano Rd, Sawgrass Village, PGA Tour Blvd., and Mickler Rd
- Majority of PVB residents oppose the widening of A1A
- Phase 1 of A1A intersection improvements to be implemented now that \$500,000 of \$3.7 million need to complete all Phase 1 improvements has been obtained. Improvements will take place at the Solano Rd. intersection, which has the highest number of traffic incidents and congestion
- Phase 2 will address the area around JTB and A1A
- Success will be measured by maintaining ambiance of small-town beach feel, zero-related traffic deaths, fewer accidents, new and alternative transportation solutions

4. Save Guana Now, Nicole Crosby

- A hearing is scheduled for 9/17 at the County Administration Building. Support the efforts of Save Guana Now by wearing a white shirt to the hearing, emailing the County Commissioners, and informing friends of the cause
- The goal of the group is to preserve 100 acres of environmentally-sensitive land
- The parcel in question has held "Conservation" status for 30 years. Allowing residential development of the parcel questions the efficacy of County's Comprehensive Land Use Map

5. Save Ponte Vedra Beach, Lori Moffett

- Lori received the volunteer of the year award for St. Johns County
- Goal of the group is to develop a beach re-nourishment. SJC does not have a strong history of investing in infrastructure
- SJC has a budget surplus and a portion of the budget should be allocated to the protecting the beach. 40% of SJC tax revenue is generated in PVB. PVB residents should email the Commissioners to request funds for the beach

6. Growth Management (GMTRAC), Dick Williams

- The proposed development of a critical care facility by St. Vincent's has been pulled by the developer due to drainage issues
- The development of "Villages of PV" (52,000+ sq. ft. office/retail/120-room hotel) is on hold, due to 31 unanswered comments submitted by SJC
- The proposed Community Marina (south of the PV bridge) had an approval appealed, which was upheld, due to concerns from local neighborhoods
- The PVO Marina has a number of open comments and is thus on hold
