Meeting Minutes 4/10/2017

The meeting was called to order. The March 2017 minutes and Treasurer's reports were read and approved.

The next Save Guana Now meeting will be held at the PVCA building on 4/12 at 7pm. This is an open meeting.

There will be elections for PVCA board members at the May meeting, a nominating committee has been formed.

Diane reported that as of today only 1 scholarship application has been received, the deadline is currently 4/15. Reminders will go out on Next Door, the PVCA website, to PVHS and Nease Career and College Coordinators, and possibly on Facebook. The deadline will be moved back to 4/30.

GMTRAC: Commander Brian Herrington with St Johns Sheriff's Office was at the last GMTRAC meeting to give updates on traffic citations and accidents. SJSO understands that we would like consistent presence in Palm Valley. The Canal Blvd shops have received ARC approval on their design. There were concerns about the exterior of that building and the owner has made some modifications. PVCA plans to contact the owner to discuss these concerns and if that does not work then an appeal will be filed to bring this to the BCC for review. The committee is also attempting to contact the builder at the property on the corner of Landrum and Palm Valley Blvd to discuss the landscaping to make sure that it will be acceptable. Next GMTRAC meeting is 5/2.

The CTTF will present the results of the TPO traffic study on 4/25 at the Ponte Vedra Concert Hall beginning at 4:30 pm. The changes that are recommended are not funded so the next step after a plan is settled on will be to look for funding to make the changes that are approved.

PV Greenway: Interested in getting the Palm Valley history story on video which would be a way to tell the story on the area of the greenway.

Beautification: Currently we are waiting to see how the roundabout recovers after the spring rains. The county is currently mowing about every 6 weeks. There is a need to reinvigorate the committee to see if we can find a way to deal with this problem area. The fence at the roundabout pond has been repaired.

Facility update: Frank reported that multiple small repairs have been made including the pressure washing of the building.
