• Finalize the Welcome Packet items decided for the mailer from the last meeting to be sent to new neighbors in Palm Valley.

We reviewed the introduction note and the history recap and decided we needed some additional information on the history recap, to bring it up to date. <u>GREG</u> will provide to <u>Deborah</u> some additional commentary. The membership drive has been successful so far, but we want more, so we discussed other opportunities. One identified last night was the sign ups for 2016 of folks who were members in 2015. We determined we have a good amount that hasn't paid their dues for 2016. <u>Frank</u> will discuss the topic with <u>Ethel</u> and do an analysis of the 2015 members vs. the 2016 membership and identify the ones we need to talk to. There was a thought that because we don't have an actual expiration process, people may not realize they need to sign up annually.

Review Greenway project and determine how we can help the effort

<u>Deb Chapin</u>, who is leading the committee working on the PVCA Greenway project, presented to us what she is saying to community members about the project via a presentation the committee has put together. The committees made some suggestions to help the impact the presentation makes, and clear up any confusion some folks may have had about what it is. We also suggested that after some revisions we establish a page on the PVCA website for the project to allow those visitors to understand the plans and how they may be able to help. <u>Deborah</u> will handle that. Perhaps a Facebook page would be applicable as well.
