MEETING MINUTES - October 12, 2015

A monthly meeting of the membership and board of the Palm Valley Community Association was held at the Canal Blvd. community center building.

The minutes and treasurers reports were read and approved.

There were no reports on the Ponte Vedra Coalition or St John's Count Roundtable. Our representative and board member Ridge Bolgiano has passed away, a moment of silence was held in his memory.

Action Committee Reports: GMTRAC - A deputy sheriff was at the last meeting of the GMTRAC committee and heard the groups concerns over traffic. Deb Chapin spoke about a possible green pathway in Palm Valley that would enhance the connectivity of the community and link into the existing sidewalks. They are working with the East Coast Greenway Alliance and will be presenting to the county in 2 weeks. PVPV Citizens Traffic Task Force representative reported that it will need an estimated \$200,000 for a traffic study from Neck Road area to North of Marsh Landing. There are no current plans for enhancing or building roads in our area. Our communications and Marketing committee laid out their membership drive plan, they have the new website up and running and the address is www.PalmValleyCommunity.org and members are invited to go the site to see the events calendar, meeting minutes, and photo gallery. The committee is always looking for photos to post on our website. The Beautification committee reported that the permitting process has started for their projects and the estimated cost for all projects is about \$30,000. The events committee is looking for volunteers to assist with the projects and Mike Wicks encouraged all members to call him if you see things in Palm Valley that don't look right in our area. The Events committee is working on the next Food Truck Friday event which will be held on 10/23/2015 at the Palm Valley Outdoors. Signs for that event are currently going up. They are also providing assistance in the planning of the Palm Valley Light and Boat Parade which will take place on 12/12/2015, with the goals to increase boat participation. There will be a boat lighting seminar, new prize categories to encourage smaller boats to enter, a sponsorship program and bleacher seating is planned in some areas. The Captains meeting will be on 12/8/2015 at Palm Valley Outdoors and there will also be an awards banquet. The committee is looking for volunteers to judge docks.

A proposal to change the bylaws of the Palm Valley Community Center Article III to allow an increase in membership dues to \$20 for individual voting members and \$100 for Business voting members and also change Article VIII which modifies the process in which changes to the bylaws are made was approved by a majority vote.

Our next meeting will be held on November 9, 2015.
