

SUBJECT: SEPTEMBER 29, 2016 BEAUTIFICATION COMMITTEE CONFERENCE CALL

The PVCA Beautification Committee held a conference call on Sept 29, 2016 with the following members to discuss the Mickler Roundabout maintenance plan- Deb Lamir, Frank Eckstein, Mike Wicks and Victoria Corlazzoli were in attendance.

The committee members discussed the following:

1. Deb Lamir discussed the overall concern regarding the roundabout and the continued lack of acceptable maintenance by the county. PVCA would like to have a standard that shortens the current mowing schedule from every 4-6 weeks down to 3-4. The plan needs to include the center circle, the 3 points leading up to circle and all outer bands including both retention pond areas. All grasses and groundcover need to be mowed regularly.
2. There is currently a plan on the table from the county involving the center circle exclusively. The plan also involves the surrendering of all liability by the county. The latter is considered to be unacceptable by the PVCA.
3. Mike Wicks discussed an option of financially supplementing the county to help with the reductions in the current county budget. This is a consideration that must continue to be explored with the public works dept.
4. Frank Eckstein has made contact with the Publix shopping center owner and together they have devised a proposal to take over the roundabout maintenance altogether. It involves incorporating it into their current landscape contract. There is however a concern over liability and until that concern is cleared this may not be a viable option.
5. PVCA will request a follow up meeting with the county to fine tune the current county proposed plan. We will communicate our specific maintenance plan and requested neighborhood standards at that time.
